***NOTE –** When your refuse collection is cancelled, you may leave up to three extra bags at the curb on your next collection day at no charge.

Items collected at curbside: newspapers, magazines, computer paper and cardboard; aluminum cans, glass bottles and jars; plastic soda bottles, water and milk jugs, and detergent bottles (no bleach bottles). Please prepare recyclables according to the instructions below and place at your regular collection point by 7:00am on the dates of collection. Recycling containers are available for pick-up by Kutztown residents at 105 Railroad Street, between 7:00am and 3:30pm, Monday through Friday. **CONTAINERS MUST NOT EXCEED 50 LBS AND MUST BE OF A MANAGEABLE SIZE (55 GAL. DRUMS NOT ACCEPTABLE).**

HOW TO RECYCLE

Aluminum	Beer and soda cans only (No Tin Cans) – need not be rinsed.
Glass	Please rinse, remove lids or caps, and separate by color into individual recycling buckets – labels may remain. MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTABLE: mirrors, ceramic cups and plates, clay flowerpots, crystal, light bulbs, window glass, heat resistant ovenware and kitchen glasses.
Newspaper	Bundle with string – please use paper bags, NOT plastic bags.
Cardboard	Must be flattened. <u>All paper can be commingled.</u>
Magazines	Bundle with string.
Computer Paper	Bundle with string.
Mixed Paper	Junk mail, folders, non-wax food packages, telephone books, school and office papers and clean pizza boxes. Remove any synthetic materials – cellophane, staples, plastic, windows on envelopes and carbon paper. Flatten all food packaging, bundle separately with string.
Plastic	Remove all caps. Plastic recyclables may be commingled and put into one container of your choice, except for 55-gallon drums. The recycling crew will not remove these containers. MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTABLE: oil containers (cooking and motor), clear plastic food trays (ex: salads, precooked meals, etc.), cat litter containers and anti-freeze containers.

Make recycling a habit. MIXED RECYCLABLES WILL NOT BE PICKED UP, and caps must be removed from all plastic containers.

IMPORTANT: ALL RECYCLABLE MATERIALS MUST BE SEPARATED, PUT INTO PROVIDED CONTAINERS AND PLACED AT THE REGULAR COLLECTION POINT FOR PICK-UP.
