• Discuss AMP and PMEA Member Training Agreement for Council Approval Mr. Diehl explained that AMP will be providing training to PMEA members, and if a PMEA member attends a training, the agreement needs to be signed and approved by the municipality. He stated if that field were to be developed, the right-of-way should be noted and the developer should take it into account when planning where trees, shrubs, fence etc. will be placed. Committee members also agreed that the right-of-way needs to remain accessible to the electric department.
