APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Discuss Customer Billed Yard Lighting

Mr. Diehl discussed a customer's dusk to dawn light which came down in a recent wind storm. After discussion, members and Mr. Diehl decided to not install a replacement

pole and light, and will recommend the resident install their own personal back yard lighting.
