NEW BUSINESS

• Discuss Replacement of Electric Department Truck #115

Mr. Diehl stated the replacement truck has been ordered. Old truck #115 is to be sold on Municibid.

Discuss the Electric Vehicle Charging Rate

Mr. Diehl explained the State will be assessing tax on this income, going back to 2022. The state also requires an "officer" be named, which will be Mrs. Sharon Dalickas. Committee members discussed the Borough's current rate of \$1.35 per hour. Mr. Diehl stated he did some research and found some municipalities charge anywhere from \$1.50 to \$2.19 per hour. Members discussed a possible increase of the Borough's rate.

Discuss Recent Electric Outages

Mr. Diehl reviewed the recent outages and stated that squirrels and the recent storms were the cause of the outages. He explained the longest outage on June 29, 2024 was due to the phases having contact with the primary neutral, which was difficult to find.
