    - The final draft of the SS&M report was received and approved by the Kutztown Water/Waste Water (W/WW) Committee. EAC also reviewed the document and all agreed that continued monitoring is required.
    - Lisa L-K distributed a report to the EAC concerning land use and concerns over air and
      noise pollution and water requirements for the proposed data centers and warehouses
      in Maxatawney Township. It was suggested that current zoning ordinances covering
      these topics be updated as a joint effort between Kutztown and the township. Further

    - Lisa F. is working on the communication between the Scout Master and Brian Bailey in regard to rebuilding the foot bridges on the North Park and Saucony Creek trails as an Eagle Scout project.
    - Todd reported that the EAC intern is on the job. He will focus on invasive plant control, mowing and clean-up of the White Oak garden.
    - Acorn planting was performed by the KU Ornithology Club in a hard to access area of North Park. 250-300 acorns were planted with 20-25 caged. Our new intern will plant ~100 acorns along the Saucony Trail.
