A public hearing of the Kutztown Borough Council was called to order at 7:31 p.m. in the Kutztown Train Station by the President, Mr. Kevin Snyder, with other members of Borough Council present: Mr. Derek Mace, Mr. Edwin Seyler, Mr. Richard Diehm, and the Mayor, Mr. James Schlegel. Council members Mr. Scott Piscitelli and Ms. Arabel Elliott were absent. Mr. Keith Mooney, Borough Solicitor; Mr. Gabriel Khalife, Borough Manager/Treasurer; Ms. Gina M. Wiand, Borough Secretary/Public Relations and Marketing Director; Police Chief Craig Summers; Mr. Matt Hafer, Acting Community Development Director; Planning Commission representative Lisa Ladd-Kidder; Maxatawny Township representative Steve Wilson; Kutztown Community Partnership representative Allison Fuller; Northeastern Berks Emergency Medical Services representative Todd Evans; and Mr. Valdis Lacis, reporter for the Reading Eagle, were also present.

Council President Snyder opened the meeting by asking Borough Solicitor Keith Mooney to review the Ordinance for members of the public.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF KUTZTOWN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ARTICLE V OF CHAPTER 225 OF THE KUTZTOWN CODE SO AS TO REPEAL AND REENACT §225-25.1C, ENTITLED "SEPARATION REQUIREMENT", AND BY ADDING THE C-1 BUSINESS COMMERCIAL ZONING DISTRICT TO THE ZONING DISTRICTS TO WHICH THE STUDENT SEPARATION ZONE WOULD APPLY.

A motion was made by Mr. Mace, seconded by Mr. Seyler, Resolved, To adjourn the public hearing upon vote. Passed by unanimous vote. The public hearing ended at 7:33 p.m.
