A public hearing of the Kutztown Borough Council was called to order at 8:01 p.m. in the Kutztown Train Station by the President, Mr. Kevin Snyder, with other members of Borough Council present: Mr. Derek Mace, Mr. Edwin Seyler, Mr. Richard Diehm, Mr. Scott Piscitelli, Ms. Arabel Elliott and the Mayor, Mr. James Schlegel. Mr. Keith Mooney, Borough Solicitor; Mr. Gabriel Khalife, Borough Manager/Treasurer; Ms. Gina M. Wiand, Borough Secretary/Public Relations and Marketing Director; Police Chief Craig Summers; Mr. Matt Hafer, Community Development Director/Zoning Officer; Planning Commission representatives Lisa Ladd-Kidder and Michael Blicher, Jr.; Kutztown Community Partnership Community Liaison Sandy Green; Kutztown Community Library representatives Cathy Ruhf, Martin Smith and Joanne Yoder; Allentown & Auburn Railroad representative Mike Bast; Kutztown University students Ayela McDonald, Shelby Gallagher and Katelyn Quinn; and residents John Fry, Phila Back, Andy Wagaman, Warren Shaub and Eric Boyer, were also present.

Council President Snyder opened the meeting by asking Borough Solicitor Keith Mooney to review the Ordinance for members of the public.

Mr. Mooney summarized the Ordinance; noted that the Ordinance was duly advertised; and asked if anyone had questions.

John Fry asked Mr. Mooney to summarize the Ordinance again, so he did. Mr. Piscitelli explained that the Borough “basically took the state statute and copied it into our Code.”

A motion was made by Mr. Piscitelli, seconded by Mr. Mace, Resolved, To enact
and ordain the following Ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 5-2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF KUTZTOWN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF KUTZTOWN BY AMENDING THE BOROUGH OF KUTZTOWN ZONING ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 225, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND REGULATION OF MEDICAL MARIJUANA FACILITIES AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HERewith.

Passed by unanimous vote.
